

GREENFIELD VILLAGE

What is the issue?

- The pavement is currently rated as **fair** condition.
- 40% of the township streets are rated as being in worse condition.
- Cracked and crumbling curb needs to be replaced
- The Township has limited ways to raise revenue.
- On 4 occasions, Township residents voted down a new road levy that would have provided funding to help repair infrastructure.
- This action will prevent your street from failing (rated as poor condition) within the next few years.



What is the proposal?

- All deteriorated curb will be replaced with new concrete.
- Timber Trail, Springbrook, and Greenfringe will be resurfaced with new blacktop.
- **A 10-Year Property Assessment of \$77.76 per Year/Property.**

What is the cost of this project?

60% Township (\$134,152.80) + 40% Property Owners (\$89,435.20 over 10 years) = \$223,588

What if this project isn't completed?

- Improvements may not be performed for another 15-25 years, and
- The estimated cost will increase by over 7 times the current amount

What are the next steps?

- Sign the petition if you are in agreement with this proposal.
- When 51% of subdivision residents have signed the petition, the proposal will be presented to the Springfield Township Board of Trustees.
