Re: Hempstead Drive and Melody Lane Resurfacing Project

Dear Springfield Township Business Owner/Resident:

We are reaching out in advance of a road resurfacing project in your neighborhood.

As previously announced, Springfield Township was awarded a State Capital Improvement Project (SCIP) grant to offset the cost of resurfacing Hempstead Drive and Melody Lane. The estimated cost of this rehabilitation project is \$855,486.00 with 50% paid by the grant and the remainder paid by Springfield Township.

In order to reduce cost and to decrease the impact on local businesses and residents, this project has been combined with the Daly Road Resurfacing Project. The Daly Road Project is being funded by the Hamilton County Engineer's Office. These projects will be performed concurrently and are scheduled to start within the next month.

Ray Prus Construction has been awarded both projects through a competitive bid process. Ray Prus will perform the concrete work. John R. Jurgensen Company will be subcontracted for the asphalt portion of the project.

**In advance of the project, it is important for you to remove any landscaping, underground irrigation or wiring from the right-of-way (within 7 feet of the curb).** The one exception is mailboxes. If you have items such as an invisible fence, décor lighting or an irrigation system within these limits, please contact the Township Service Department at (513) 522-1410, or email [mgould@springfieldtwp.org](mailto:mgould@springfieldtwp.org) to schedule a meeting with a project inspector. Neither the Township, nor the construction company, is responsible for the damage of items installed within the right-of-way that are not removed.
